Dear Deputy Smith,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

According to the Strategic Workforce Planning and Intelligence April 2022 Employment Report, the current WTE for CAMHS consultants is 73.

In terms of increasing capacity, the HSE has doubled the number of Higher Specialist Training (HST) posts to graduate this year (in July) from 22 to 46. 13 of these posts will be in CAMHS. The HSE is organising for these graduates to meet HSE Heads of Service and Executive Clinical Directors (ECDs) in Community Health Organisations (CHOs) around the country, in order to enhance the linkages with graduates in terms of vacancies and opportunities.
