Dear Deputy Murnane O'Connor,

Thank you for your representation.

The COVID-19 Therapeutics programme was established to implement operational pathways for patients to access novel COVID-19 therapeutics. The programme procured two novel therapeutics for Ireland; 1) a monoclonal antibody: Sotrovimab and 2)an antiviral: Paxlovid to date.

These two therapeutics treat eligible high-priority patients who have been recently diagnosed with COVID-19, as the aims of these therapeutics is to minimise the symptoms of COVID-19 rather than the treatment for long Covid.
