## Dear Deputy Mac Lochlainn

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Ambulance turnaround times provide the time interval from ambulance arrival time (through clinical handover in the Emergency Department or Specialist Unit) to when the ambulance crew declares the readiness of the ambulance to accept another call (clear and available).

Enclosed with this response is a copy of the Hospital Turnaround times per month for 2019, 2020, 2021 and to-date 2022
