Dear Deputy Daly,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 13064/22), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

All HSE Community Audiology Services provide the option to book an appointment for repairs, if the hearing aids require investigation or refurbishment by an engineer. Hearing aids which require refurbishment or repair are sent to the National Repair Service.

Additionally, CHIME, (<https://www.chime.ie/>), offers basic maintenance of hearing aids, such as cleaning and re-tubing of ear moulds. Alternatively, many patients choose to self-manage their hearing aids, and in these cases, the HSE provides spare tubing etc. as necessary.
