To ask the Minister for Health the completion date for the renovation works of the audiology facility in a service (details supplied); and the date for the resumption of services.

Dear Deputy Stanley

Thank you for your query. The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you recently submitted. In preparing this response your Parliamentary Question has been discussed with the relevant Managers. I have examined the matter and I outline the position as follows.

The work on the sound-proof audiology room, St. Fintan's Complex, Dublin Road, Portlaoise, was completed 1-2 weeks ago but there were a number of snags that required rectifying before the room was fit for use. All actions have now been completed and the Audiology Service is now in the process of arranging a removal company to move the Audiological equipment and furniture into the renovated rooms. The service expects to recommence Audiology clinics in Portlaoise before the end of April 2022.
