Dear Deputy Murphy,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position:

The Social Inclusion Unit in Community Healthcare Organisation Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) has been in regular contact with Transgender Equality Network Ireland (TENI). Funding had been suspended by the CHO DNCC Social Inclusion in June 2021 following non receipt of 2019 audited accounts. Audited accounts for 2019 were received from TENI on 29th July 2021.

Following a full review and examination of the 2019 accounts, funding resumed from Social Inclusion in January 2022 for a period of three months until the end of March 2022 after a commitment had been given by TENI that that 2020 and 2021 accounts would be submitted before the end of first quarter of 2022.

As of 30th March, these accounts were not received and payment for April 2022 was discontinued, effective from 1st April. I can confirm that a full audit of TENI's accounts has been requested and will be actioned in 2022.

In respect of funding, the total amount provided by the HSE from both Social Inclusion and Mental Health to TENI for the period 2014 – 2021 was €1,590,833.00.
