PQ 16525/22- Deputy David Cullinane- To ask the Minister for Health if Sotrovimab is available for use in Ireland, the extent to which it is available; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

Thank you for your representation.

Sotrovimab is available in all hospitals in Ireland for the treatment of patients who are positive for COVID19. Sotrovimab is a monoclonal antibody which is administered via an intravenous infusion.

As of 28 March 2022, there were 616 doses of Sotrovimab administered in Irish hospitals. A number of the patients treated were referred by GP's for treatment consideration.
