Dear Deputy Cronin,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The management of patients with possible or confirmed COVID-19 in acute hospitals is underpinned by the Acute Hospital Infection Prevention and Control Precautions for Possible or Confirmed COVID-19 in a Pandemic Setting 07.03.2022 guidance and supported by continuous local risk assessment based on available information, patient need and safety. 
