Dear Deputy McDonald,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Access to hospital beds is a multifaceted issue and accommodation challenges, where they exist, are balanced to ensure timely access for patients to appropriate services. The HSE is currently progressing work through the National Quality & Patient Safety Directorate to inform guidelines on the operational practice of mixed accommodation.
