I refer to your recent PQ which has been forwarded to me for attention.

PQ: To ask the Minister for Health the total amount charged for parking at Children's Health Ireland locations in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021; the total revenue generated by parking charges; the net revenue generated for the hospital by parking charges; and if he will make a statement on the matter.
