The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

Engagement between the HSE and the School Principal has been ongoing for a number of weeks. The Meath Disability Manager advised St Mary's Special School Principal and Chairperson that following careful consideration a decision had been made to retain the SLT post in St Mary's.
