PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health the number of women in adult psychiatric units by CHO area since January 2021 to date, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter - David Cullinane

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

As per preliminary data for 2021 from the Health Research Board, the table below gives the number of female admissions by CHO area from the period 01/01/2021 to 11/05/2022 for psychiatric units only.

Please note the following:

- These figures are preliminary and are subject to change.
- Data is for psychiatric units in CHO areas only and does not include data for Psychiatric Hospitals/ Continuing Care hospitals.
- Data for Private Hospitals is not included.
