To ask the Minister for Health the number of Irish and European Union and the number of Non-European Union doctors who were awarded intern posts in each of the years 2016 to 2022, in tabular form; the number of intern posts available in each year; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

National Doctors Training and Planning (NDTP) Response

The HSE applies the Employment Permits Act in the recruitment of the intern posts. In compliance with the Employment Permits Act an order of merit based on work permit status is applied. Intern posts are allocated according to a preference system where by all eligible CAO entrants to Irish medical schools who are work permit exempt, who are tax-payer funded, are guaranteed an intern post. Following that, the remaining posts are preferentially allocated to all remaining and eligible EEA applicants, followed by all remaining and eligible non-EEA applicants. The table below provides the numbers of posts and entry category of Interns for each of the years 2016- 2021*.

^{* 854} Intern posts are available for the July 2022 Intern year, recruitment for the July intake is currently in progress.

^{**}In 2020, in response to the Covid-19 pandemic the Minister for Health requested the HSE to increase medical intern posts to provide a post for all Irish medical school graduates (CAO and Non-CAO) who wished to accept a post. This resulted in the total number of intern posts increasing to 995 for one year only. The 2021 Intern places reflects a return to a more sustainable level of interns post Covid 19. This number is aligned with the number of Posts available at the next stage of postgraduate training and workforce demand estimates.
