“To ask the Minister for Health the amount allocated to COPE in counties Cork and Kerry in 2021; the amount drawn-down; and the amount spent.”

Dear Deputy Gould,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The amount allocated to COPE in Cork Kerry Community Healthcare (Counties Cork and Kerry) in 2021 was €71,000,544. The amount paid/drawn down was 65,506,990. The difference relates to unpaid invoices which are still being processed. The amount spent will be available when we receive their Annual Financial Statement(AFS) 2021.

The figures reported here will vary from the HSE Service Provider Governance (SPG) Online System due to on- going processing and updating of information on that system.
