"To ask the Minister for Health the whole-time equivalent staff by role in each of the Cork CAMHS teams respectively, in tabular form that would be considered full staffing."

Dear Deputy Gould,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

CAMHS services are designed for children and adolescents presenting with moderate to severe mental health needs. There are a total of eight sector based community mental health teams in Cork and two sector based teams in Kerry. The CAMHS community based teams are supported by Eist Linn, Child and Adolescent Inpatient Unit. Cork Kerry Community Healthcare also have a Child & Adolescent Regional Eating Disorders service operating day programmes and outpatient services. Please see table below in relation to WTE per discipline per Cork CAMHS team as requested as of March 2022
