**Dear Deputy Whitmore** 

I refer to your recent PQ which has been forwarded to me for attention.

PQ: To ask the Minister for Health the number of children with scoliosis on the operation waiting list by hospital; the number of those who have complex needs; the average waiting times for those children; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

## Children's Health Ireland (CHI) Response:

I have followed up with Childrens Health Ireland (CHI) and the National Orthopaedic Hospital Cappagh and set out hereunder the information which you require.

Please note that below data includes all active patients waiting on spinal surgery, including those with a date scheduled for their procedure. This data does not include suspended patients.
