The number admitted; the number not admitted; the number who registered and left before a decision on admission was made; the performance against key performance indicators for each month for admitted and non-admitted patients; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The attached excel file outlines the following as requested:

- The total number of persons who presented/attended at ED for the years 2018 to date.
- The number of these patients admitted
The number of these patients not admitted.

Please note this data is extracted from a daily Patient Experience Time extract report and as it is a live dataset the overall attendance numbers will vary slightly from published ED attends.

- The number of patients who registered and left before a decision on admission was made.

Please note the data provided includes all patients who registered at ED and did not wait for treatment or admission. This is included at tab titled "Did not wait".

- ***Performance against key performance indicators for admitted and non-admitted patients.

Performance against Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) are provided as follows in line with the National Service Plan KPIs:

- Percentage of all attendees ED who are discharged or admitted within six hours of registration
- Percentage of all attendees at ED who are discharged or admitted within nine hours of registration
- Percentage of all attendees at ED who are in ED <24 hours
