Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

In order to support HSE consistent monitoring across all sites, it is important that Patient Experience Time (PET) reports align with HSE key performance indicators/targets. These targets are within time and age bands respectively.

This information is reported by HSE Business Intelligence Unit and used to manage and drive performance improvement in the following categories:

Time Bands

- 6 Hours
- 9 Hours
- 24 Hours
- Greater than 24 Hours- Please note that all patients waiting greater than 24 hours are included within this time band and could include patients waiting for longer time periods.

Age Bands

- Those aged 75 years and over
- All attendances irrespective of age

In this regard, the table hereunder sets out the available requested data which indicates the number of occasions a PET of greater than 24 hours was recorded in respect of the years outlined.
