Dear Deputy Cairns,


The Health Service Executive have been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted for the Minister for Health for a response.

The subject matter of this question is currently the subject of a formal process under the auspices of the State’s industrial relations machinery and as such, it would be contrary to fair procedures for a substantive response to be provided at this point.

It should be noted however that replies to this question have already been provided, specifically with regard to the location of the posts and dates of appointment. In total three senior posts were advertised via Health Business Services (HBS), as posts not arising from reassignments, and a total of four posts were advertised via HBS to backfill posts which were subject to reassignment. In total seven posts were advertised and filled via HBS in Cork during the period (five at senior grade and two at staff grade).

I trust the above clarifies the queries raised.
