Re PQ 56808 22: Saint John of God HR have told their staff that section 38 organisations have received no budgetary provision from the HSE to fund 3% back pay payment from February 2nd that was agreed at the recently concluded discussion on an extension to the Building Momentum public sector pay deal. Is this true and why?

Dear Deputy Healy-Rae,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Your PQ above has been referred to me for response.

Given that the amendments to the Building Momentum - Public Service Agreement 2021-2023 have only been recently agreed, funding by Government for these pay awards will be allocated to the HSE as part of the Revised Estimates Volume 2022/2023 over the coming weeks. Budgetary allocations will then be made to Section 38 organisations once this funding has been allocated to the HSE by Government.
