Response:


Pain Service has been fully operationally throughout 2022 with both outpatient clinics and day case activity ongoing for Chronic Pain. A service interruption to Chronic pain outpatient clinics has taken place in October and November. However, a plan is now in place to recommence these clinics in the next two weeks.

Service enhancements took place in 2021 with the restarting, post covid, of Acute Pain Management Programme to provide much needed service for patients living with acute pain.

There is a team of 6.4 wtes working in across this service area, in addition to one permanent Consultant in Pain Medicine and one consultant who is due to take up permanent post in 2023.
