Dear Deputy O'Callaghan,

The National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions which you submitted to the Minister for response.

- The Recruitment process within the National Ambulance Service operates within the National Recruitment Services of the HSE and criteria is set for minimum entry grade in line with the Recruitment Licence.
- Graduates from Universities including UL who meet the criteria and are successful at the interview stage will be employed by the HSE.
- The National Ambulance Service does not seek information on where a candidate obtained their qualification, only that they hold PHECC registration.
