Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Response:

In relation to PQ'S 57792/22 and 57793/22, collection of cancellations data began in February 2022 so we are unable to provide data or information for these two PQ's.

In relation to PQ'S 57790/22 and 57791/22, please find in appendix 1, data in relation to the Parliamentary Questions related to cancellations.

Definition of a hospital initiated inpatient/day case cancellation

A hospital initiated cancellation of an inpatient/day case procedure is defined as the rescheduling of a patient To Come In (TCI) date by the hospital due to circumstances beyond its control.

Reasons for cancellation of scheduled care appointments

Hospitals may have to cancel scheduled care appointments due to factors outside their control including the following:

- Increased ED attendances and admissions resulting in a requirement for surge inpatient bed capacity
- II. Unforeseen circumstances e.g. Weather events, infection outbreaks or industrial action.

Rescheduling hospital appointments

Hospitals endeavour to provide the patient with as much notice as possible in relation to the cancellation of elective appointments. The National Inpatient, Day Case, Planned Procedure (IDPP) waiting list management protocol 2017 issued by the National Treatment Purchase Fund (NTPF) requires hospitals to reschedule elective care appointments within six weeks of cancellation, subject to patient confirmation regarding their availability to attend. Clinical guidance must be sought when managing and rescheduling patients cancelled by the hospital. This is necessary to ensure that urgent and vulnerable patients are rescheduled appropriately. Patients cancelled by the hospital will not have their waiting list date reset.

Notes

There are additional notes in the attachment with regards to hospitals exclusions from the report, but also note the below:

- We cannot provide cancellations data by appointment type or speciality, we can only provide this by service area which is broken out as follows (New / Return OPD, Elective Inpatient, Chemo, Dialysis, GI Scope and All Other Day Cases). Therefore both PQ 57790/20 & PQ 57791/22 are answered in the attached.
- Tallaght University Hospital have sent data on a weekly basis to us but this has been excluded due to an outstanding validation process which is currently taking place. BIU continues to engage and work with the hospital and relevant staff in this regard.

- National Maternity Hospital have not provided cancellations data to date, however they are currently in the process of setting up a data feed to provide us with cancellations data. BIU continues to engage and work with the hospital and relevant staff in this regard.
- St. Luke's Radiation Oncology Data is also excluded while a review of their data is undertaken. BIU continues to engage and work with the hospital and relevant staff in this regard.

Note that hospitals highlighted in red denote a partial return of data, this is where a hospital has not returned data for all services areas where we expect data to be returned.

I trust that this answers your question.
