To ask the Minister for Health the number of children in County Clare referred and waiting to be seen by CDNT services by length of time waiting in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

## **Dear Deputy Wynne**

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Please find below table which lists the number of Children and how long each Child is waiting in days:

5	2 months
8	3 months
4	4 months
1	5 months
3	6 months

2	8 months
2	9 months
3	10 months
Total 42	1-10 months

There is a waiting period for access to the Clare Children's Disability Network Team (CDNT). The HSE are aware that there is a staffing resource challenge across all teams within the Midwest as caseloads have risen significantly over the past 10 years and the Midwest Community Healthcare is continuously highlighting this need with submissions for additional resources. The HSE also review resources on a regular basis to allocate any available additional funding to priority areas. The Clare CDNT continues to monitor the waiting times and availability of supports, and continues to seek additional resources accordingly.
