Thank you for your question to the Minister for Health, which was forwarded to my office to respond to you directly.

The HSE provides funding of approximately €880,000 to the Irish Family Planning Association (IFPA) and the Well Woman Clinic in respect of salaries, training, supervision, administrative support, IT and communications associated with the provision of services by these agencies, including termination of pregnancy and counselling.
