To ask the Minister for Health the current number of vacancies within the children's disability network services in County Wexford; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Murphy,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

I can confirm that SECH CHO 5 secured funding for 26 new posts across the CDNTs in the National Service Plan 2022. The HSE are actively recruiting to fill these posts along with trying to fill current vacancies which will enable teams to increase the provision of assessment and intervention. Senior Speech and Language Therapy interviews were scheduled for September 2022. A SECH/National panel has been formed for Occupational Therapy with a national supplementary campaign underway and a Senior Physiotherapy panel was formed in July 2022. A Staff Grade Physiotherapy national panel is underway. A Senior Psychology/Staff Grade Psychology national panel is now in place.
