To ask the Minister for Health further to Parliamentary Question No. 827 of 12 July 2022, if he will confirm that the staffing issue with the children's disability network team in Carlow has been resolved; if staffing levels have risen beyond 3.51; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Funchion,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

As outlined in my recent correspondence to you (PQ 37234/22) the whole time equivalent (WTE) Speech and Language Therapist (SLT) post allocation to Children's Disability Network Team (CDNT) in Carlow is 3.51. CDNT - Network 1 Carlow currently has one Speech and Language Therapist (SLT) working 3 days per week (0.71 WTE). The remaining 2.8 WTE SLT posts are vacant.

As with other areas disability services within South East Community Healthcare (SECH) are experiencing significant recruitment challenges. A SECH campaign has recently concluded for Senior SLT and a Staff Grade SLT national campaign is currently underway. Unfortunately, to date CDNT - Network 1 has been unsuccessful in filling the Senior SLT post from the recent panel.
