The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which were submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following composite response outlines the current position in relation to vacant South East Community Healthcare posts.

As with other areas disability services within South East Community Healthcare (SECH) are experiencing significant recruitment challenges. SECH continues to express posts out to current national panels and continues to prioritise local recruitment campaigns. We are acutely aware of the high demand for services in our CHO and the impact of delays in accessing services on children and families. In the interim, the Children's Disability Network Managers (CDNM) are exploring different ways to offer support to children and families currently waiting to access services. This includes developing webinars, group based workshops, information sessions and the development of a repository of resources for children and their families to promote and enable wellbeing at home.

From a national perspective significant challenges are being experienced in relation to the on-going recruitment of allied health professionals. Within South East Community Healthcare there is a continued focus on the recruitment across all therapy grades.
