## Response


The HSE does not hold the information requested centrally, I have checked with National Cancer control Programme (NCCP) at Cancer Intelligence, they only collect KPI data on the number of new patients completing parenteral systemic therapy in the day ward setting which is only a subset of all chemotherapy activity. No data is captured regarding number of visits and DNAs by the NCCP, this data would need to be collected from individual cancer centres if available.

The individual cancer centres are listed below. Designated Cancer Centres:
