To ask the Minister for Health the number of individual family service plans that have been produced within the CDNT5 and South Tipperary to date in 2022; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Mc Grath,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

The Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNT) work closely with children and families to identify the child's needs and the family's own priorities and agree a plan i.e. Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) to support children and parents to reach goals identified in the plan.

The table below outlines the number of IFSPs produced in South Tipperary to date in 2022:

Children's Disability Network Team (CDNT)	Number of IFSP (*to date 2022)

CDNT - Network 4 Cashel	73
