Dear Deputy Higgins,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response. I requested PDS Project Manager Children's Disability Services and Lead for Children's Disability Services to examine the matter and the following outlines the position.

There are currently 11 Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNTs) established for Dublin South, Kildare & West Wicklow Community Healthcare and three of these teams serve the former HSE Local Health Office configuration of Dublin West:

- Clondalkin CDNT – Lead Agency CRC
- Rossecourt CDNT (Lucan) – Lead Agency Stewarts Care
- Palmerstown CDNT (Palmerstown/Ballyfermot) – Lead Agency Stewarts Care.

The three CDNTs in the former LHO of Dublin South West are:

- St Columba's, Armagh Road CDNT (Dublin 12)– Lead Agency HSE
- Tymon CDNT (Tallaght/Firhouse) – Lead Agency Enable Ireland
- Chamber House (Tallaght West/Newcastle) – Lead Agency HSE


