Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The table below represents the number of hours D-Doc has provided urgent GP out of hours care in Dublin North City and County from 2018 to date (9<sup>th</sup> October 2022). A slight decrease in provision for 2021 was largely due to IT/network failures which have now been resolved.
