"To ask the Minister for Health the current staffing breakdown at West Kerry Community Hospital; the way this compares with the numbers at the start of this year; if extra beds will be opened at the hospital; the specific efforts that are being made to recruit new nurses at the hospital including a breakdown of details of advertisements that have been made in 2022; and if he will make a statement on the matter".

Dear Deputy Griffin,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

West Kerry Community Hospital (WKCH) provides a valuable service to people living in the West Kerry area and Cork Kerry Community Healthcare is committed to increasing the staff complement at WKCH in order to augment service provision for the local community. Extensive efforts continue to recruit staff to WKCH and to overcome the challenges that recruitment to community hospitals in rural locations can present.

The below table sets out the current (October 2022) staffing breakdown at WKCH together with comparative data from January 2022:

Staffing levels have increased in WKCH across almost every grade since the start of 2022, following the numerous local recruitment campaigns that have been undertaken in the past year. The opening of additional beds at WKCH is a service priority and to this end we will continue to seek qualified and interested candidates within this geographical area to facilitate same.
