To ask the Minister for Health the amount of funding, excluding the nursing home support scheme that was given to each HSE nursing home and community hospital to implement measures to prevent and manage Covid-19 outbreaks in 2020 and 2021, in tabular form; the expenditure incurred to implement these measures; and if he will make a statement on the matter..
