Dear Deputy O'Dowd,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

Currently there are 1.6 outreach workers in Louth Meath. One WTE covering Dundalk and 0.6 WTE covering Navan. There are 2 vacant outreach worker positions across the Louth Meath area that have been advertised recently one will be based in Drogheda. The HSE have also secured additional funding for another outreach worker for the Louth Meath area.
