To ask the Minister for Health the steps that he is taking to recruit additional staff into the National Ambulance Service; the number of graduates from Irish paramedic science degree courses that have been recruited into the NAS in each of the years 2015 to 2021 and to date in 2022, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter

Dear Deputy Shortall,

The National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the minister for response.

As of September 2022, 25 of the additional 128 WTEs under this funding stream have been recruited. The NAS expects further significant recruitment in the remainder of Quarter 3 and in Quarter 4 2022 and has confirmed that it expects recruitment of all 128 positions to have taken place by the year-end.

For 2023 recruitment planning, NAS has made a submission through the 2023 Estimates process to recruit another 192 Student Paramedics across NAS programmes starting in January and September 2023 as well as growing educational capacity by opening a fourth campus in 2023 in the South of the country. In 2023, recruitment competitions are also planned for 50 Medical Emergency Controllers and 25 Intermediate Care Operatives.

The NAS College delivers the required training to all staff through our Education and Competency Assurance Officers, both within the college and across the service. Our Bachelor of Science Degree in Paramedic Studies is delivered in conjunction with University College, Cork, across our three NAS College campuses in Tallaght, Ballinasloe and Tullamore.

There is no ready supply of paramedics in Ireland and therefore, NAS for the most part must educate our own workforce in our own college. The Paramedic Programme is to a degree level and it takes three years to complete, with the latest group of 62 paramedics qualified at the end of August 2022. These are now taking up new positions across the country in locations no more than 45km from their home address.

NAS are also planning to commence classes of 30 Intermediate Care Operatives in October 2022 and a further 30 in November 2022 at the NAS College for training and a further batch of 30 in the first half of next year. NAS will also be shortly instigating the recruitment of Emergency Call Takers for the National Emergency Operations Centre sites in Tallaght and Ballyshannon, Co Donegal. NAS will be training at least 12 Call Takers at the end of the year to refresh the existing numbers at the centres.
