Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The following capital projects are currently ongoing at the Mater Misericordiae University Hospital.

### **Emergency Ward Block**

Construction of a new 112 bed ward block, comprising ninety four single rooms with ventilation and high-flow oxygen delivery and sixteen intensive care beds. This project is being delivered on a phased handover basis.

Phase 2 (Level 4)	January 2023
Phase 3 (Levels 5 & 6)	March 2023

### **Major Trauma Centre**

The Mater Hospital was recently selected to be the Major Trauma Centre in Dublin. This project will be delivered in phases, commencing with:

- Phase 1A: An extension to the existing emergency department including the three trauma bays, radiology computed tomography (CT) services, provision of interventional radiology services and associated accommodation to address the anticipated increase in demand associated with the major trauma centre. This is an interim development.

- Phase 1B: The provision of two trauma theatres, a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) suite and ancillary accommodation to address the anticipated increase in trauma demand associated with the major trauma centre.
