Thank you for your parliamentary question above, which has been forwarded to me for direct reply.

I am providing the information by number of reimbursements as opposed to patient numbers. We do not collate information by patient we collate it by application. A patient could submit more than one application for reimbursement if he/she had attended a hospital abroad on more than one occasion or for more than one course of treatment.

The tables below provide details of the number of reimbursements processed under the HSE CBD since 2018 to August 2022 and under the HSE Northern Ireland Planned Healthcare Scheme since its inception in 2021 to August 2022.
