Dear Deputy Ó Snodaigh

I refer to your recent PQ which has been forwarded to me for attention.

PQ: To ask the Minister for Health the reason that there are no outpatient dietitian appointments in Our Lady's Children's Hospital Crumlin.

Childrens Health Ireland (CHI) Response:

Childrens Health Ireland (CHI) at Crumlin currently have limited outpatient clinics. Priority is given to infants and young children under the age of 2 years who require tube feeding and nutritional support. This patient cohort undergo rapid growth and neurodevelopment, which is dependent on adequate nutrition. Many of these children are ex-inpatients with complex medical needs or children diagnosed with a chronic long term illness who attend speciality teams.

There have been significant periods of staff shortages/ vacancies over the last 2 years, at which time outpatient clinics have been reduced or postponed. Inpatient dietetic support was prioritised to acute or critically unwell infants and children.
