In response to this Parliamentary Question, please see table below which provides the details of the amount spent annually on rent for the primary care centres located in Bandon, Bantry, Clonakilty and Mizen for the years 2020 to 2022 in tabular form as requested.

Bantry (lease commencement in 2021)	-	€163,395.36	€393,438.88
Clonakilty	€275,909.84	€266,923.82	€255,274.22
Mizen (Schull)	€229,286.93	€229,286.93	€230,222.80

The HSE own the Primary Care Centre in Dunmanway in conjunction with a GP practice, therefore there is no rent paid for the Dunmanway PCC building.
