**Dear Deputy Shortall,**

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the following Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to this Department for response.

**PQ 17852/23**

**To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons on a waiting list for homecare packages; the number of persons experiencing delayed discharge from hospital due to a delay accessing homecare; and the waiting lists for home care packages by CHO and LHO, in tabular form**

The Home Support Service is funded by Government to deliver a volume of service each year as approved in the HSE National Service Plan. It is a non-statutory service and access to the current service is based on an assessment of the person's needs by the HSE, having regard to the available resources and the competing demands for the service. The volume and type of service provided to each client is based on individually assessed care needs and will vary dependent on the needs identified and the resources available to meet those needs.

Demand for Home Support continues to increase due to population growth and the increasing dependency of the growing numbers of people aged  $\geq 80$  years, within the over 65 years' cohort. Waiting lists for Home Support have become a feature of the service, now primarily associated with an increasing capacity issue related to the availability of care staff. In terms of those waiting, priority is given to those in the community with acute needs and to those assessed and waiting in acute hospitals, who are in a position to return home with supports. Funding approval for Home Support for those assessed as requiring same is expedited across the system to ensure minimum waiting times.

Available waiting list data reflects those that have been assessed and waiting for the provision of Home support. Please see Appendix 1 below for a breakdown of the Home Support Waiting List as at end of March 2023 by CHO and LHO.

In terms of Delayed Transfer of Care Report (DTCR) activity as at the 29th March shows that of the 604 people delayed in the acute system at that date, 91 were categorised as Type A, Destination Home, Of these, 15 had submitted their application for their Home Support Package (HSP) but were waiting for funding with 54 others having funding approved but were waiting on carer availability.
