**PQ 18157/23\* To ask the Minister for Health if he will provide a list of all primary care centres open, under construction and planned; the number of centres that are publicly owned, privately leased, and public private partnerships, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -Rose Conway-Walsh**

Dear Deputy Conway Walsh,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

In response to this Parliamentary Question, please find enclosed a spreadsheet which provides the details on all primary care centres open, under construction and planned as requested.

The “Operational PCCs” (Appendix 1) tab lists the location and delivery mechanism of 167 operational primary care centres.

In summary, the number of operational primary care centres delivered under each mechanism is contained in the table below as requested.
