Dear Deputy Crowe,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 19411/23) which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Please note that the authorisation of insulin pumps occurs at an LHO level, and as such, there is not a national database which collates the information centrally or records the number of persons who are approved for insulin pumps each year.

However, the total number of patients who have been prescribed Roche AccuChek insulin pumps to date, and who are currently using them is recorded, and is detailed in the below table. A breakdown by age is not available for this company.
