Dear Deputy Hourigan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

As previously communicated in our response to Parliamentary Question 1143/23, the works for Glenwood House were not tendered, as due to the Covid 19 Emergency there was a derogation regarding the tender process. The contractors were engaged via negotiation.

As requested the names of the contractors who carried out the works on Glenwood House, Carrigaline are listed in the table below.
