**“To ask the Minister for Health the caseload and headcount of staff and children awaiting intervention in the north Cork city and Blarney children's disability network team, in tabular form.”**

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Children’s Disability Network Teams (CDNTs) have been established to provide services and supports for all children with complex needs within a defined geographic area.

As part of the HSE National Service Plan (NSP) 2021, a total of 100 development posts were allocated for PDS and its implementation. Under Phase 1 and Phase 2 Cork Kerry Community Healthcare (CKCH) received 7.5 wte posts with an additional of 5.8 posts under Minister Rabbittes Special School allocation. 2022 NSP posts approved in Phase I was 14.5 WTE and of the 25.9 posts for special schools awarded in August, 22.2 WTE are for Cork network teams and the number, if applicable, for **North Cork City & Blarney CDNT** is reflected in the table below - discussions are ongoing in relation to breakdown into specific roles for special schools.
