The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in regard to your Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Please see hereunder table outlining the population covered by each Community Healthcare Network (CHN) in CHO3. The population figures provided are informed by Census 2016 as the details from Census 2022 are not due to be released until April 2023.
