PQ Question: To ask the Minister for Health further to Parliamentary Question No. 632 of 18 October 2022, to detail the number of appropriate placements and placements supports that are currently in place for students studying speech and language therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy and psychology in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter - Pauline Tully.

Dear Deputy Tully,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in relation to the above parliamentary question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The number of placements for students studying speech and language therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy and psychology are listed in the table attached.

In relation to supports, I can advise that trainee clinical psychologists are employees of the HSE for three years during their doctoral programmes and while undergoing placements. Current salary is €37,850 x 3 years. They also receive 60% towards the cost of their fees. There are no similar arrangements or supports applying to the other professions listed.
