Time Bands

- 6 Hours
- 9 Hours
- 24 Hours
- Greater than 24 Hours- Please note that all patients waiting greater than 24 hours are included within this time band and could include patients waiting for longer time periods.



Age Bands

- All attendances irrespective of age
- Those aged 75 years and over

In this regard, patients aged over 60 are not a national KPI and therefore not report. I have provided the information for all admissions and those aged >75 years in the attached excel template.
