Dear Deputy Burke,

The data collected in the CDR is anonymised and cannot be traced directly back to an individual patient by the HSE. However the GP monitors the blood and renal tests which were done as part of the OCF, and if these indicate kidney impairment, the GP will enrol the patient on the Prevention Programme which is part of the CDM Programme.
