"To ask the Minister for Health the number of young persons aged 0-24 years of age who have travelled outside of the Republic of Ireland for specialised cancer treatment not available in Ireland in 2022 via the HSE treatment abroad scheme; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Ó Cuív,

Thank you for your parliamentary question referenced above, which has been forwarded to me for direct reply.

In general the Treatment Abroad Scheme which is based on EU Regulation 883/2004 allows a public patient in Ireland apply for funding to access healthcare in the public healthcare system of another EU/EEA country, the UK or Switzerland. Applications for funding are subject to specific criteria including that the treatment is not available in Ireland, the treatment is a proven form of treatment, the treatment will be provided in a recognised public hospital, etc.

I can confirm that 19 patients, aged between 0-24 years of age were approved for funding, under the Treatment Abroad Scheme in 2022 for treatment of cancer.
